We all know that we had an unprecedentedly unusual year at Trinity Wellsprings Church in 2016. We also had an amazing response to the Gifted Christmas Challenge and overall year end giving. Your faithfulness to God's work through Trinity has been overwhelming. Giving to the "Challenge" and giving to the Building Mortgage Fund totaled \$136,613 in December. That allowed us to overcome a \$74,926 deficit and end with a surplus of \$35,519.

We also ended the year with a surplus in the General Fund of \$14,626. Praise the Lord! Your response and sacrifice allows us to begin 2017 with an overall surplus of \$50,145. What a gift you all have given Trinity, our mission partners, our ministries, and our new pastor by allowing us to begin the year in a very healthy financial position.

Now we need to show that same financial faithfulness as we begin the year.
