Today, grab a bowl of water, a bar of soap, & a towel and participate in a **"Stay-at-Home" Foot Washing** following our 7:00 pm **Maundy Thursday** service filled with worship, drama, & short teachings by Rev. Tom Mayo & myself. (*Live alone? No problem, just follow the instructions at the end of the service!*)

On **Good Friday**, join us at 12:00 noon for a short time of worship & a dramatic reading on "The Science of the Cross". Register before 12:30 for a **VIRTUAL LUNCH** and we'll send you a link to join an online video call where I will be doing a DEEP DIVE on the biblical/theological meaning of THE CROSS. Buckle up for 30 minut es of community and meditating on the cross!

On Holy Saturday, register HERE for a "Holy Saturday Silent Retreat" where a spiritual director (yours truly) will guide you *before* and *after* a 90-minute Silent Retreat. I'll also explain what "Holy Saturday" means in the Christian tradition and we'll wrap up by sharing together -- in community -- our spiritual pilgrimage during the retreat.
