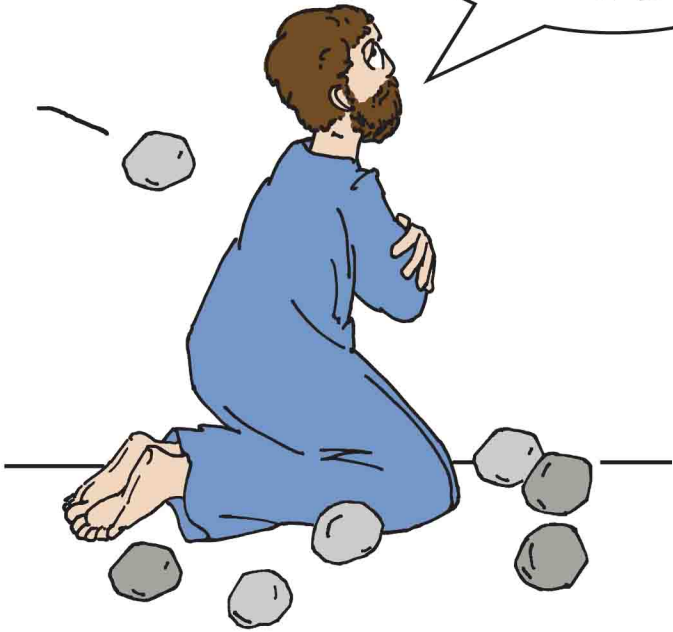
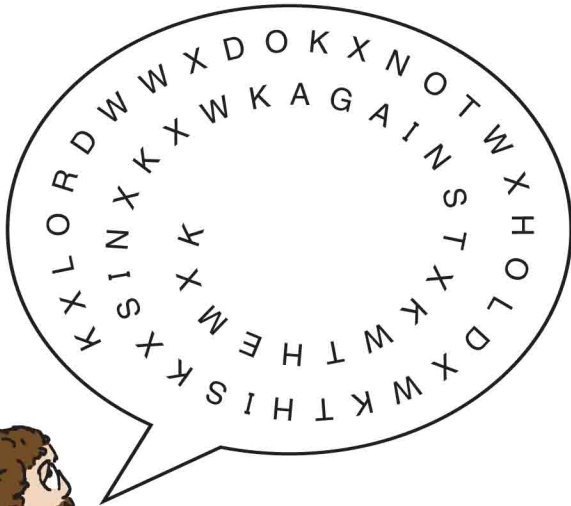


The Jewish leaders were cruel, but Stephen responded with forgiveness.

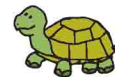
