



TWC Covid Response | January 5, 2022

In light of the significant uptake in covid cases caused by the Omicron variant, the leadership of Trinity Wellsprings Church has opted for the following measures beginning this Sunday, January 9th and for the next few weeks:

- (1) **9:45 WORSHIP SERVICE** – Will meet **outside** in **THE TENT** behind the BeachHouse. We will have chairs for most, but it would be great if some could **bring their own folding chairs and/or blankets** for the kids/family. Hopefully, we will enjoy a beautiful day enjoying God’s good creation!
- (2) **8:30 WORSHIP SERVICE** – Will meet in the Sanctuary in order to practice social distancing and utilize the Live Stream equipment.

Other changes until further notice include: (1) No Greeting Time, (2) No Passing of Offering Plate. For the indoor service, the sections of the sanctuary will be designated (Mask Preferred, Mask Optional, No Mask) but Session would like to encourage the use of masks especially during the singing.

Session will meet at the end of January to re-assess the ongoing situation. It is our hope that these changes will be implemented for a few weeks rather than endless months (like the last time we utilized the tent).

Children will be dismissed to The Boardwalk mid-way through the 9:45 service, and the staff working with children will be utilizing masks.
