Every day throughout the year and in the summertime, Neighbor Up Brevard provides a safe haven & holistic programming for youth and teens in the Booker T. Washington area of Melbourne. At the DOCK, youth unwind, get academic tutoring, empowerment and enrichment, experiential learning, and so much more. The Greater Heights Apartments offer affordable housing for working families and seniors on the site of what was once a block notorious for criminal activity. In a joint project with the City of Melbourne and Brevard County, the dilapidated, asbestos-riddled structures were demolished; in their place is now a haven of clean, well-maintained, and colorful apartments.
