Over the next 18 months, pray for and considering joining a global mission trip as our church family breaks out of our small American silos to come alongside global churches, work on the frontier, engage with the needs of our big world, and form lasting relationships in the gospel with the worldwide body of Christ.

July 20-24, 2026: Joint TWC-FCA Basketball Mission Trip – Central America

Did you know that sports is one of the universal human languages that God often uses as a bridge to share the gospel of Jesus Christ?

Trinity Wellsprings Church (TWC) is partnering with Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) to send a small team to Central America to explore opportunities for a new FCA Sports Camp.

Why this location: We chose this site because we will be hosted by long-term friends and ministry partners of TWC Pastors. We will travel every day into the neighborhoods where those ministry friends have been serving for decades. Pastor Mike and his family have lived there. The Space Coast Fellows year is built around its annual trip there.



What do we bring to the mission? This trip is shaped around youth sports, team-building, and practical faith conversations. A Sports Camp can excel where construction-based mission trips often struggle—equitable, cross-cultural relationships in Christ that are long-lasting and gospel-centered. FCA Sports Camps like this all over the world are shaping athletes by sharing Christ through shared passion and competition.

What we gain in the process: This trip aims to expose our beachside athletes to international missions and sports-based ministry. The week away will stretch them physically and mentally. But it is also a time away with Jesus. We are responding to His call to “love one another deeply” (1 Peter 4:8) and to “come away with Me... and rest awhile” (Mark 6:31). We want to cultivate life-long mindsets of service, hard-work, and humility under the yoke of Christ.

How: These trips are designed to be a running partnership between FCA and TWC. We feel so blessed to be invited into this opportunity by these local coaches and our ministry friends on the ground in Central America.

Who is invited? The initial stages of this partnership will involve FCA staff, coaches, and selected athletes.

September 8-14, 2026: Brussels, Belgium – Iranian Diaspora Church

Did you know that the Iranian church has been the fastest growing church in the world for the last half decade?

Trinity is planning a “vision trip” to work with an Iranian Diaspora Church located in Brussels, Belgium (Sept 8-14, 2026). We will engage relationally with leadership and the church body, coming alongside our brothers and sisters in their outreach efforts to serve meals, assist with homeless ministry, and reach out to refugees.



Future Partnership? Supporting future discipleship conferences, training, and leadership development are a few examples of what may be possible in a partnership to help the Iranian church grow with a firm, biblical foundation.

How You Can Pray: A specific point of prayer & dialogue will be centered on how our church might participate hand-in-hand with this church in their Summer 2027 All-Church Retreat and Conference. They would welcome our gifts and talents in a setting ideal for discipleship and building lasting relationships.

The City: Brussels is a vibrant city, known for its many museums. We will stay near Grand Place (or Grote Markt in Dutch) in the heart of Brussels, which is often regarded as one of the most beautiful squares in the world. It is surrounded by Baroque guild halls, the impressive Town Hall, and the neo-Gothic King's House (Maison du Roi), which houses the Brussels City Museum. In 1998, the Grand Place was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Cost: The total cost of this visit is \$2,195 per person for double occupancy (an additional \$375 for single occupancy). The cost includes food, lodging, and in-country transportation. Team members are responsible for arranging their own international travel to Brussels (BRU) and return.

Who is Invited: Please prayerfully consider being a part of this vision team of 6-10 people, *alongside Rev. Elmer*, who will start building relationships with the church in Brussels and walking alongside this diaspora Iranian church.

9-10 Days in Early October, 2027: Cairo, Egypt – Synod of the Nile

Did you know that the Synod of the Nile (a sister Presbyterian denomination) is one of the most vibrant Christ-centered missions-hearted churches in the entire Middle East?

God is on the move in Egypt. Over the last couple decades, God has been using Egyptian Presbyterians who pray, fast, and strategize for missions to build the Kingdom of God in the Middle East! The mission mobilizing agency, Frontier Fellowship, is helping build the capacity of the Egyptian Church to train church planters, expand mission work to unreached areas, and increase collaboration for mission in Egypt and beyond.

Invitation: Come rub shoulders with Egyptian Christians on fire for the Lord Jesus in a culture that is embedded in and surrounded by Islam. Is there a church-to-church partnership that might develop through this vision trip as we listen to the Holy Spirit guiding our church forward in global mission?

Come experience the Egyptian church in action. Build relationships with church planters in messy hard-to-reach areas. Engage in ministry & relationship in the vibrant city of Cairo while visiting the historical parts of Egypt including the Pyramids of Giza, the famous Great Sphinx, and more.

Dates: Early Oct 2027; *exact dates TBD*. **Cost:** Exact cost TBD; with a range most likely \$3,000-\$3,500.
